Watercolor

Techniques

What is it?

- "Transparent Painting"
- Pigment mixed with water
- Painted on watercolor paper
- Unpredictable

Water color dries lighter!

Test colors

- If your pallet dries... its ok, just add water

Wet on DRY

- Paint applied to a DRY surface

- Color built up with washes (layers of transparent colors)

- Next color applied when first layer is dry

Wet on Wet

- Paint applied on WET paper

- Paint is applied before the last color dries

Gradation

- Smooth transition from light to dark

- A wash with more water added to each line

Dry Brush

Dry brush of saturated color

Sponge

Add paint to sponge and use as a brush

Lifting

When painting still wet use dry sponge to lift color

Salt

Timing is everything.

- Not too wet, not too dry. Just before the sheen is gone absorbs the paint wipe off when dry

- 1.You are watching the Superbowl halftime show, and Bruno Mars doesn't show up! Then the broncos lose
- 2.Miley Cyrus fell off of a wrecking ball
- 3. You are walking down the street and see a large group of people planking... Then they start doing the Harlem shake
- 4.Yolo
